The US Postal Service has a new run of stamps and on the 17th at Mount Vernon they will have an official unveiling. John and Bonnie will attend, and others are welcome.

Our Herd book has been updated.

The Directors have received positive feedback on the Card grading video and it has been used by many throughout year.

Moving forward in 2023, there will be a celebration about the arrival of Devons at Plimouth. More information to come.

We continue to research working with the University of Utah on milk and meat samples We have a figure of \$25,000 for a study on lab animals regarding our meat/milk and Cancer prevention. We are looking for funding.

In order to take grants a 501c needs to be created. We are studying the pro/cons.
